

**Joint Privacy Policy pursuant to Article 13 of the EU General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679 ("GDPR") on the personal data processing for the selection for and participation in the Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Programme in Astrophysics and Space Science EMJM-MASS**

<p><b>2. Categories of collected personal data</b></p>	<p>Within the framework of the EMJM-MASS Consortium Agreement and in accordance with Article 4 of the GDPR, Joint Data Controllers shall process personal data of applicants who submit their applications for the EMJM-MASS selection and of students admitted to the EMJM-MASS. Collected data are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- personal data (first name, surname, signature, place and date of birth, address, gender, Italian taxpayer code);</li> <li>- contact details (e-mail address and phone number);</li> <li>- student's ID number;</li> <li>- copy of identity document (identity card, passport);</li> <li>- curriculum vitae (cv);</li> <li>- copy of the Bachelor's Degree and/or Master Degree;</li> <li>- academic records including an explanation of the grade scale;</li> <li>- certificates documenting extracurricular activities;</li> <li>- motivation letter;</li> <li>- recommendation letters;</li> <li>- student's transcript of records;</li> <li>- certificates of English language proficiency;</li> <li>- transcripts of records acquired within the EMJM-MASS</li> </ul>

	<p>Only for admitted students the following data will be collected:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- copy of the visa,</li> <li>- Italian telephone number,</li> <li>- proof of application for Italian residence permit,</li> <li>- European bank account coordinates;</li> <li>- health data regarding special needs and in the case of serious illness</li> </ul> <p>The Joint Data Controllers could process special categories of personal data (medical certificates concerning disabilities and/or special needs for which dedicated services are required, if the students want to receive special support/ treatment in this regard) pursuant to Article 9, par. 2, letter g of GDPR in conjunction with laws aimed at ensuring support and assistance for students with disabilities.</p>
<p><b>3. Source of personal data</b></p>	<p>Pursuant to Article 13 of the GDPR, the personal data listed above are collected directly from the Data Subject at the time of application.</p>
<p><b>4. Purpose(s) of data processing</b></p>	<p>Personal data shall be processed for delivering the MASS Programme and, in particular, for the following purposes.</p> <p><b>4.1) Evaluation of student's application: selection finalized to subsequent admission to the EMJM-MASS;</b></p> <p><b>4.2) management of the student career within the EMJM- MASS;</b></p> <p><b>4.3) management of the formal application appeal or complaint presented by the student through the appropriate complaint form according to Article 9.1 of the Student Agreement signed by the student, a template of which is available on the MASS website at the following link: <a href="https://www.master-mass.eu/students/">https://www.master-mass.eu/students/</a>;</b></p> <p><b>4.4) data concerning health conditions may be processed in order to provide data subjects with the necessary services or in case health problems affect the student participation in the program and in case the data subjects cannot continue with their studies because of an unexpected and severe sickness;</b></p> <p><b>4.5) the student's European bank account coordinates will be processed for the payment of any scholarship and/or any reimbursement of student's expenses.</b></p> <p>Lawfulness of processing is the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- for the purposes of points 4.1), 4.2), 4.3) and 4,5), article 6, paragraph 1, letter e) of the GDPR ("<i>performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the [Joint Data] Controller[s]</i>") in conjunction the relevant legislation of the Higher Education applicable to the relevant Controller regulating the processing of student data;</li> <li>- for the purposes of point 4.4), article 6, paragraph 1, letter e) of the GDPR ("<i>performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the [Joint Data] Controller[s]</i>") in conjunction the relevant legislation of the Higher Education applicable to the relevant Controller regulating the processing of student data and article 9, paragraph 2, letter g) of the GDPR ("<i>processing is necessary for reasons of substantial public interest</i>") in conjunction with laws aimed at ensuring support and assistance for students with</li> </ul>

	disabilities. The student consent will be collected at the time of the student relevant request.
<b>5. Recipients of personal data</b>	<p>To the extent which is necessary, personal data are communicated only to authorized Joint Controllers personnel (teaching staff, including researchers, employees and collaborators).</p> <p>The personal data will be also transferred to the University of Belgrade, as Full Partner of the EMJM-MASS pursuant to article 46 of GDPR (see point 10).</p> <p>The Joint Data Controllers make use of a hosting service provider for collecting, storing and sharing personal data. In this case the service provider shall act processor pursuant to art. 28 of GDPR.</p> <p>The personal data of the selected applicants (name, surname, gender, date of birth, nationality and email) may be communicated to “CX Place Rome”, (located in Via di Passo Lombardo 341, 00133 Rome) in order to provide selected applicants with housing assistance.</p> <p>The personal data of the selected applicants that confirmed their participation in the EMJM-MASS (name, surname, date and place of birth, nationality and email) will be communicated to either “Aon International People Mobility, Admiraliteitskade 62, 3063 ED, PO Box 1005, 3000 BA, Rotterdam, the Netherlands” or “DR-WALTER Versicherungsmakler GmbH, Eisenerzstraße 34, 53819 Neunkirchen-Seelscheid” in order to provide them with a full travel and health insurance package. Medical certificates concerning disabilities and/or special needs, for which dedicated services are required will be communicated to the European Education and Culture Executive Agency (EACEA) for reporting.</p>
<b>6. Data Retention Period</b>	Joint Controllers will keep the personal data of the Data Subjects for five years from the conclusion of the project.
<b>7. <b>8. Obligation to provide data</b>	Data provision is necessary for the purposes set out in point 4 of the present joint privacy policy.
<b>9. Processing method(s) of Personal Data</b>	Personal data shall be processed with both IT tools and any other type of suitable support, in compliance with appropriate security measures according to Article 5, paragraph 1, letter f, of the GDPR.
<b>10. Transfer of</b>	Personal data of the Data Subjects are transferred to the

<b>personal data abroad</b>	University of Belgrade, as Full Partner of the EMJM-MASS throughout the “Standard Data Protection Clauses” adopted by the European Commission in accordance with article 46 of the GDPR.
